This is an 8 track album with full teaching resources commissioned by **Leicester**shire Music and created by professional composer Jack Ross working with 4 of our special schools. Follow Where The River Flows has 8 songs in a lovely range of styles about a very school-appropriate range of topics (friends, moving on, anger, rivers, space...).

The songs are perfectly crafted for simple learning for our pupils with additional needs, with catchy and repetitive choruses and some lovely open vocalisation sections as well as space for percussion/signing/dancing/sensory opportunities (Shiny Big Balloon is a favourite!)
