Programme

75 Years of Music Making

2023 marks a special milestone in the history of Music Making within Leicester and Leicestershire as we celebrate 75 years of music making.

Leicestershire Music's origins began way back in 1948 when our founder Eric Pinkett decided that young people in Leicester & Leicestershire should have access to musical opportunities and the chance to learn and perform. With considerable determination, this vision was realised and the first orchestra held their first performance at Church Langton Primary School. The Leicestershire County Music School – as it was then known, grew quickly over the next few years to include several orchestras and bands of different ability levels, allowing students to progress as they learned and gain more experience, with regular performances at De Montfort Hall in Leicester – a legacy which continues to this day.



Under Eric Pinkett's leadership until the late 1970's, the Music School became very highly regarded throughout the country, providing a blueprint for other music organisations to follow. In particular, the Leicestershire Schools Symphony Orchestra became known globally as one of the best Youth Orchestras around, regularly recording, featuring on television, working with many famous name conductors and completing many highly successful European tours. In the 1980's the Music School expanded to include Dance and Drama, becoming known as *Leicestershire Arts in Education* and moving to Knighton Fields Centre which was to be our base for the next 30 years. Thousands of young people passed through KFC as it became known, learning and performing Music Dance and Drama with many performances taking place at KFC itself, along now regular venues such as De Montfort Hall, Haymarket Theatre and The Phoenix.

As we entered a new millennium, the times, funding and landscape of Music Education changed which resulted in a new name, base and offer being developed for young people - resulting in us becoming Leicester-Shire Schools Music Service (LSMS), moving our office base to Abington House and returning to a purely musical offer, largely within schools across the city and county.

In 2021, with a strong belief that music should be for all young people regardless of their situation, background or musical interest, LSMS became **Leicestershire** Music – reflecting our belief that we are and music is for ALL young people in Leicester and Leicestershire (not just through schools), further strengthening our Partnership work with local, regional and national organisations to ensure a wide breadth of quality and relevant musical opportunities are available to access.

Thank you to everyone who has both helped and taken part in our journey so far – we look forward to continuing to enthuse and inspire a lifelong love for music in the young people of Leicester and Leicestershire for a further 75 years and beyond!

Liberian Folk Song features the percussion section and uses very effective melodic and harmonic layering across the band. It is a super little piece of standard beginner band repertoire that really brings out the sonority of the ensemble whilst allowing all timbres to be heard clearly.

A *Shakers March* is a traditional tune that many of you will recognise. The arranger John Kinyon clearly understands the needs of the young band. Each section of the ensemble is featured as well as the whole band. The piece is a great learning tool for the young ensemble.

Forest Gump (Title Theme). Everyone will recognise the melody here and remember Tom Hanks' outstanding performance as Forest. John Williams has scored the music of movies from *Jaws* to *Star Wars*, *E.T.* to *Harry Potter*, and his melodic mastery is evident once again in this timeless tune.

Blues March was written back in the 80's by a young David Garodi. It is a fun work based on the 12-bar blues that we have adapted to include solos within our ensemble.

These young musicians began playing last year in year 7 as part of a class based project and the band formed shortly afterwards. This is the first concert band at Babington Academy and they are paving the way for a new wave of instrumentalists.

Our present year 7's musicians have now reached a standard that they are ready to begin working as part of an ensemble. The vision is, over time, to develop a strong instrumental programme at Babington, offering our students a valuable life-long learning opportunity.

Leics Create

Leics Create is a creative project led by **Leicestershire** Music, Orchestras Live and Sinfonia Viva, which brings together young people from across Leicester and Leicestershire who are currently learning to play their instrument and beginning their musical journey. The piece that you will hear this evening was partly written by Raph Clarkson and Matt Davis on the theme of celebration for **Leicestershire** Music's 75th year. The piece is entitled *Leics Create Celebration* includes space for the young musicians to create their own music within the piece.

The rehearsals were facilitated by Sinfonia Viva and **Leicestershire** Music musicians at Langmoor, Fairfield, Thistly Meadow, Newbold Verdon and Elizabeth Woodville Primary Schools, **Leicestershire** Music Junior Concert Band and Intermediate Strings.
