Leics Create: Leicester Leaps Out

In Partnership with Sinfonia Viva and Orchestras Live

Leics Create is a creative programme which enables young people at the very start of their musical journey to create music, and to perform together as part of a large ensemble. This year we will premiere the third **Leics Create** piece, **Leicester Leaps Out**, which has been co-composed by Pete Letanka, and young people from across Leicester and Leicestershire. The piece takes its inspiration from the jazz standard *Lester Leaps In*, famously performed by Lester Young and the Count Basie Orchestra, and our version focusses on celebrating Leicester.

Young musicians have been working with their **Leicestershire** Music leaders over recent months in preparation for the concert this evening. The group includes young musicians from:

Ashmount School, Birch Wood School, **Leicestershire** Music Jam Band, **Leicestershire** Music Junior Concert Band, Langmoor Primary School, Thistly Meadow Primary School, St Peter's CE Primary Academy, **Leicestershire** Music Strictly Strings.

The young musicians you will see on stage, have created some of the music themselves, inspired by Leicester. You will see the words that have inspired the rhythms and melodies they will play on the screens. The young people are supported by musicians from **Leicestershire** Music, Blues and Roots Ensemble and Sinfonia Viva during the performance.

Leicester Leaps Out includes several sections; a song which was co-created by Pete Letanka and the Jam Band; instrumental riffs which the students have learned to play and a creative section where each group has made their own rhythms and melodies. The song lyrics are:

Leicester Leaps Out

*We've gotta let people hear the music You know it's time to shine!
We've gotta get everyone together! Come on it's party time!*

*You see everyone around you smiling, There's something in the air.
And now is the time when Leicester leaps out! We've got so much to share.*
