Conflict of Interest Policy

All members of the **Leicester**shire Music Hub Board will strive to avoid any conflict of interest between the interests of the Hub on the one hand, and personal, professional, and business interests on the other. This includes avoiding actual conflicts of interest as well as the perception of conflicts of interest.

The purpose of this policy is to protect the integrity of **Leicester**shire Music Hub's decision-making process, to enable our stakeholders to have confidence in our integrity, and to protect the integrity and reputation of the Executive Board members.

Examples of conflicts of interest include:

- A Board member who is also a service user who must decide whether fees from users should be increased.
- A Board member who is also on the committee of another organisation that is competing for the same funding.
- A Board member who has shares or financial interest in an organisation or business that may be awarded funding or a contract to do work or provide services on behalf of the Hub.

Upon appointment to the Board each member will complete a disclosure of interest form (see Appendix). Completed forms will be kept on file and will be reviewed annually or sooner depending on any changes in circumstances.

During Board meetings, members will be asked to disclose any interests relating to the items on the agenda. This will include where there is likely to be a conflict between the Hub and the Board members best interests or a conflict between two organisations that the Board member is involved with.

During a meeting, should a conflict of interest be declared regarding an agenda item the Board Chair will decide as to the relevant actions to take. For example, this may include asking the Board member to leave the meeting room whilst the agenda item is being discussed and inhibiting that member from taking part in any decisions being made. Any such disclosure and the subsequent actions taken will be noted in the minutes.

This policy is meant to supplement good judgment, and Board members should respect its spirit as well as its wording.
