This week your challenge is create your own music.

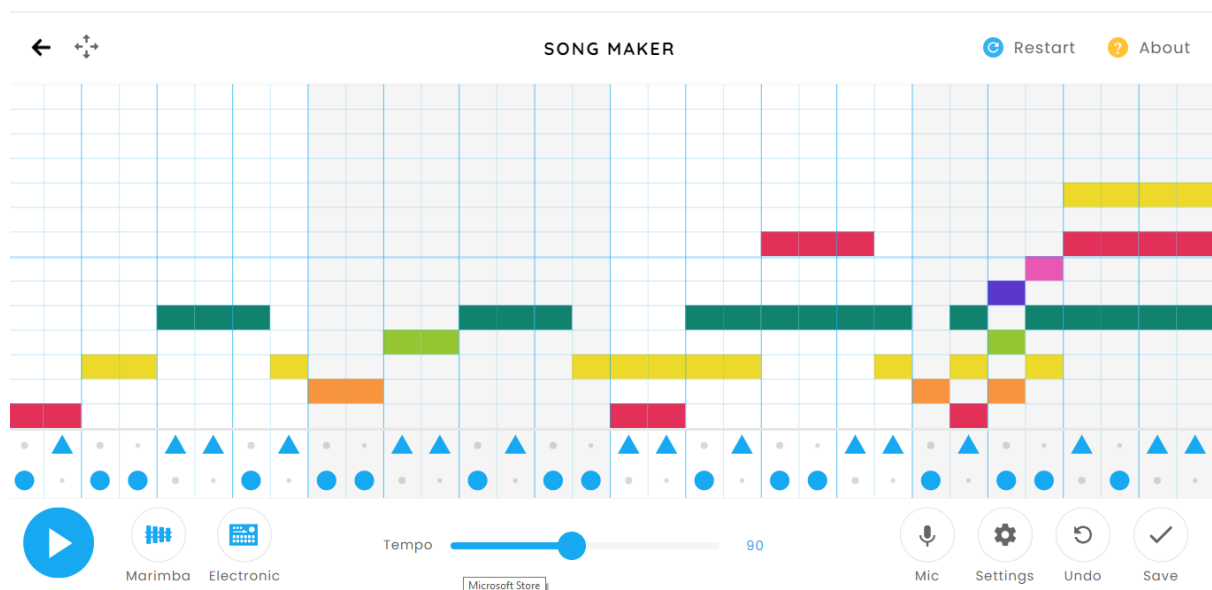

Song maker is a really easy to use piece of software where you can experiment with percussion rhythms and notes to produce your own piece of music.

- The different coloured squares represent different notes and you just click on them to add them or click again to take them away. Which notes sound nice together which ones clash when sounding at the same time?
- The Blue circles and triangles are the percussion or rhythm instruments. Click on them as with the pitched notes above.

- The bottom of the screen has lots of options you can change (from left to right)
 - The play button to listen back to what you produce
 - The tuned/pitched instrument that you can swap
 - The percussion instrument that you can swap
 - A tempo slide, to alter the speed of you piece of music
 - Mic – if you want to add your own sound
 - Settings – if you want to change more advanced pulse etc.
 - Undo – as it says
 - Save – this will save a link to your music.

When you are happy with your final piece please email it to your class teacher who can pass it on to me. I look forward to hearing all your fantastic music ideas.

You can't get this wrong, this is YOUR piece of music. Tweak it and experiment with as many ideas as you want to.
