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Music and the interrelated dimensions of music - Write about one of the interrelated dimensions of music in regards to the music you have listened to. Does it change throughout the piece of music?

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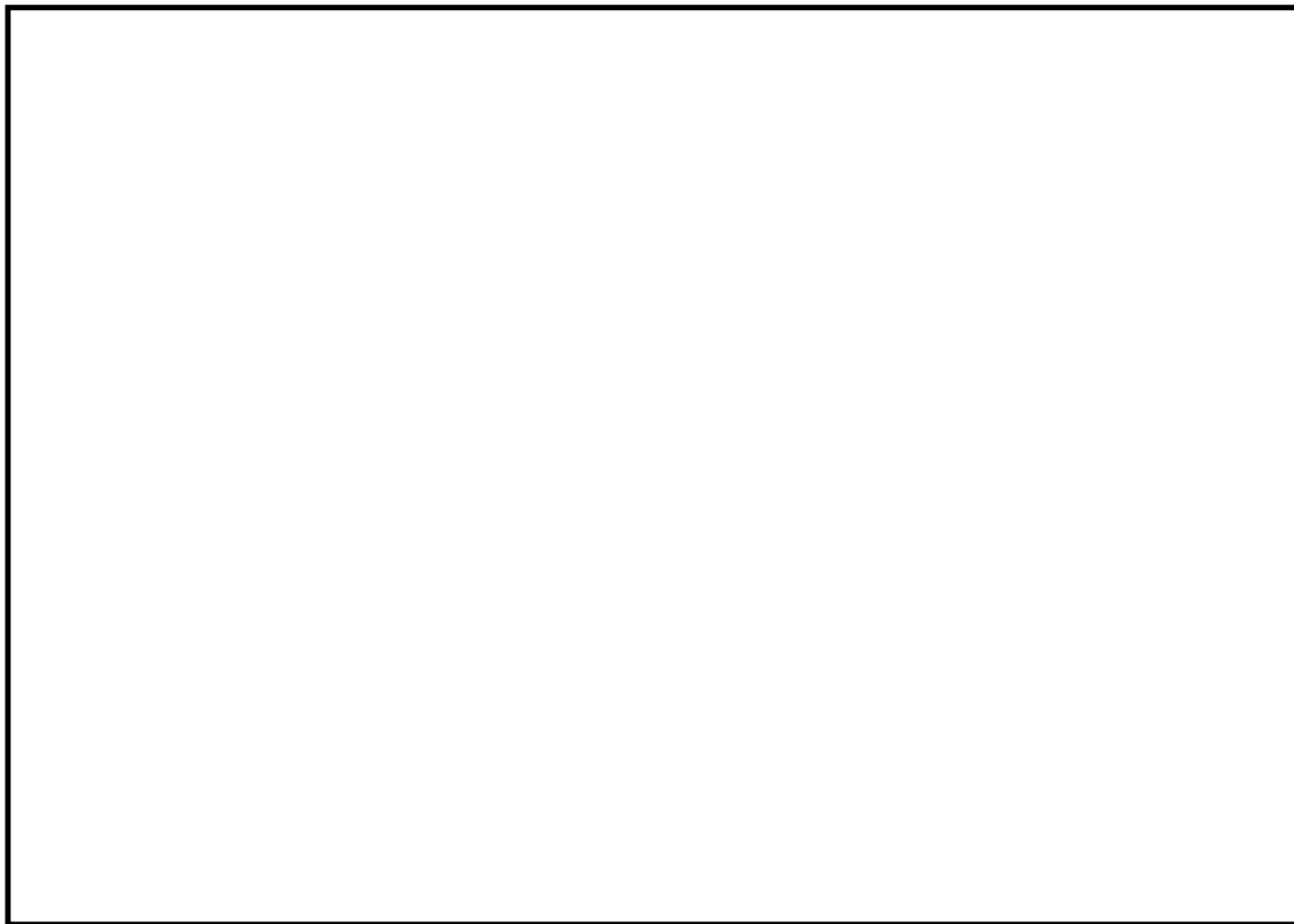
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Create a soundscape - Draw a picture landscape of the music you have listened to
