**Assessment**

- Do you evaluate other children's music making?
- Do you know how well you are doing in music/instrumental lessons?
- Do you have time to reflect on what you have learnt and think about what went well and what didn't in preparation for the next lesson?
- My teacher gives me feedback (advice) that I can act upon.
- I am given the opportunity to mark and comment on my own work.
- I feel that I am making good progress in this subject.
